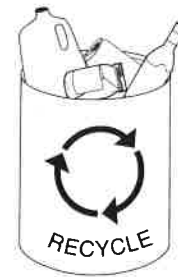

**THE CENTER ACCEPTS THE FOLLOWING ITEMS TO BE COMINGLED TO BE EMPTIED FROM YOUR TRANSPORT CONTAINERS OR FROM BAGS INTO SPECIFIC RECEPTABLE**



**ALL COLORS OF GLASS, TIN CANS AND PETE & HDPE PLASTICS (IN ONE BIN)**

**ALL CARBOARD & MIXED PAPER PRODUCTS SHOULD BE  
FLATTENED, BAGGED or BOXED TO BE DEPOSITED INTO DESIGNATED AREA  
SHREDDED PAPER IS ACCEPTED IN PLASTIC BAGS**

**SCRAP IRON OR METAL ITEMS & ALUMINUM CANS ARE ACCEPTED**

**APPLIANCES & ELECTRONICS - MAY BE BROUGHT TO THE CENTER**

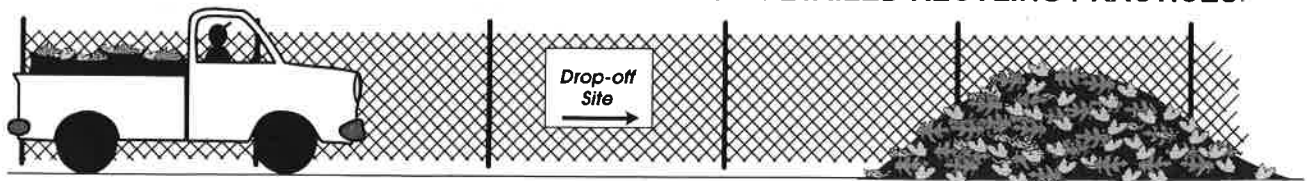
**Washers, Dryers, Water Heaters, Stoves with no fee.  
Dehumidifiers, Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, TV's, Computers, Microwaves  
are accepted for a fee collected by the recycle attendant.**

**LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES NOT ACCEPTED-DISPOSE OF AT MANITOWOC COUNTY CLEAN SWEEP EVENT**

**VEHICLE/EQUIPMENT OIL, FILTERS OR ABSORBANTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND BANNED FROM  
LANDFILLS-DISPOSE AT A MANITOWOC COUNTY CLEAN SWEEP EVENT**

PLEASE SEE THE INSIDE OF THIS FLYER FOR DETAILED RECYCLING PRACTICES.**

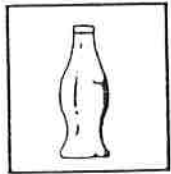


**THE COMPOST CENTER IS OPEN TO RESIDENTS OF VALDERS AT ALL TIMES

NO STUMPS OR SCRAP LUMBER IS ACCEPTED.  
VILLAGE RESIDENTS MAY USE COMPOSTED GROUND-CHIPPED BRUSH FOR LANDSCAPING.**

Writing, Computer & Copier Paper & All Envelopes



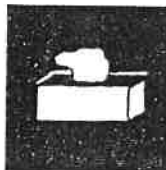
Grocery Bags & Bulk Mail

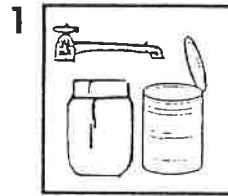
MIXED PAPER includes many types of waste paper products generated in the home. Paper products **MUST** be dry and free of food residues and restroom waste.

PAPER can be mixed together and placed in bags or small boxes which can also be recycled. Flatten boxes to save space. Place separated paper on top of, or next to, your full recycling bin.

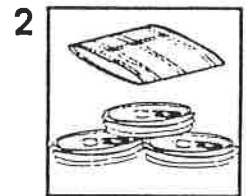
CORRUGATED CARDBOARD **MUST** be flattened and boxed, bagged.

NEWSPAPERS **MUST** be boxed, bagged.

## PREPARING GLASS AND CANS FOR RECYCLING

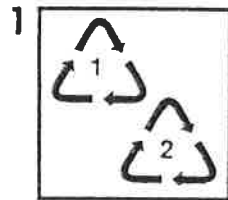


1 RINSE your cans and glass.

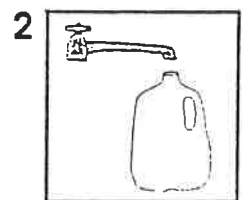


2 CRUSH cans if possible to save space.

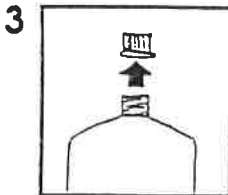
## PREPARING PLASTIC FOR RECYCLING



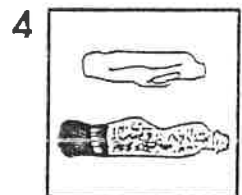
1 IDENTIFY: Only containers with these codes (on the bottom of the container) are acceptable; the base must be larger than opening.



2 RINSE your containers. You don't have to remove any labels.



3 REMOVE caps, rings and pumps and place them with regular garbage.



4 FLATTEN, if possible, so it takes up less space.
